## Services we offer

### **Psychological Services**

- Free confidential counseling and assistance to pregnant women of all ages and denominations.
- Psychological Evaluations
- Individual and Family Counseling

### **Community Assistance**

CCW accepts donations of diapers, formula, infant clothing, (0-2 years) and gently used baby items. We maintain a store of diapers and infant formula for families in need.

### **Family Care Coordination**

Wrap around is a team based model designed to enhance the strengths of the child and family through natural and professional supports. A team of community professionals is formed and headed by the FCC to ensure high fidelity wrap around services for youth and families.

### **Adoption**

Catholic Charities is a licensed non-profit adoption agency created in 1964. We provide both pregnancy and adoption services throughout the state of Wyoming.

Pregnancy services are provided free of charge. The agency provides adoption services to those seeking newborn infants or children with special needs. Assistance with a home study and post placement supervision can also be provided to residents working with an out of state or international adoption agency.

### **Foster Care**

CCW is committed to being a resource for children ages 0-18 years old, who are in need of out-of-home placement. We work with DFS as well as other agencies and entities that have the authority to place children in temporary foster care. Foster care is the temporary 24-hour care of children who cannot remain in their own home. This provides children with protection and nurturing while the biological

parents work toward meeting specified goals as part of the overall treatment plan. CCW works primarily with children in need of intensive services.

### **Case Management**

Case Management wrap around services enhance foster care through in home support and intervention. Support includes treatment planning, transportation, making appointments, crisis intervention, and educational and therapeutic monitoring. Case management can also address independent living and can arrange mentoring for children. Case managers are also involved with adoption and pregnancy counseling services.
